TUESDAY LUNCH PROGRAM - Pizza Pizza!



Round 2 of Tuesday school hot lunch program will run for 5 Tuesdays starting October 15th until November 12th, 2024.

We are offering 3 sizes of individual pizzas (5-inch, 10-inch and 12-inch gluten-free) from Pizza Pizza. Cost of each pizza size is below:

- 5-inch Pizza by the slice (cheese, pepperoni, halal pepperoni) \$14.50 (\$2.75/week x 5 weeks + \$.75 (school cash surcharge fee)
- 10-inch Boxed Pizzas:

Cheese Pizza - \$38.00 (\$7.25/week x 5 weeks + \$1.75 (school cash surcharge)

Pepperoni Pizza - \$44.50 (\$8.50/week x 5 weeks + \$2.00 (school cash surcharge)

Veggie Pizza (mushroom, green pepper, tomatoes) - \$48.50 (\$9.25/week x 5 weeks + \$2.25 (school cash surcharge)

• 12-inch Gluten-Free Pizza

Cheese Pizza - \$63.00

(\$12.00/week x 5 weeks + \$3.00 (school cash surcharge)

Pepperoni - \$70.75

(\$13.50/week x 5 weeks + \$3.25 (school cash surcharge)

Deliveries will be made on the following Tuesdays: October 15th, 22nd, 29th, November 5th and 12th, 2024. Each pizza comes in an individual box allowing students to bring leftovers back home in their pizza box. You are welcome to order more than one per child if you wish.

If your child wishes to take part, please remit your payment through our cashless schools on the school website or through this link starting September 27th until October 6th at 4:00 pm.
